

Overview of Emergency Safety Interventions (ESI) Reporting



➤ Emergency Safety Interventions

- ❖ Seclusion and restraint are considered emergency safety interventions (ESI).

➤ Kansas State Board of Education (KSBE) Regulations

- ❖ Schools must report on the use of restraint and the use of seclusion for all students. K.A.R. 91-42-2(b)(3).

➤ Reports

- ❖ The use of ESI is reported through KAN-DIS, <https://online.ksde.org/authentication/login.aspx>.
- ❖ All instances of use of ESI for all students must be reported quarterly (Student ID#, date of the incident, and length of the use of an ESI in minutes).
- ❖ Schools must complete ESI reports quarterly even if there are zero incidents to report.

➤ Purpose

- ❖ Information gathered from the quarterly reports will be collected and presented to the Special Education Advisory Council to assist and guide recommendations for further action by KSBE.

➤ Quarterly Reporting Dates

- ❖ 1st Quarter Entry Dates: July 1, 2013 – September 30, 2013
- ❖ 1st Quarter Submission Window: October 15, 2013
- ❖ 2nd Quarter Entry Dates: October 1, 2013 – December 31, 2013
- ❖ 2nd Quarter Submission Deadline: January 15, 2014
- ❖ 3rd Quarter Entry Dates: January 1, 2014 – March 31, 2014
- ❖ 3rd Quarter Submission Deadline: April 15, 2014
- ❖ 4th Quarter Entry Dates: April 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014
- ❖ 4th Quarter Submission Deadline: June 30, 2014
