2. Verbal Bullying

- Name calling, mocking, hurtful teasing
- Humiliating or threatening someone
- Making people do things they don't want to

3. Social Bullying

- Excluding other from the group
- Spreading gossip or rumors about others
- Making others feel foolish
- Making sure others do not like or spend time with a certain student

4. Electronic bullying – (internet, phone, text messages)

- To hurt someone's feelings
- To make someone look bad or foolish
- To threaten someone
