Step 1: In your groups decide who will be responsible for...

- Sharing back with the larger group – Speaker

Step 3: As a group talk about each one of the questions on the handout. Make sure you have someone who is...

- Making sure everyone has a chance to share – Leader
- Moving to the next question based on the time you have – Leader
- Taking notes on the comments, thoughts and questions – Recorder
- Ready to share key points with the larger group – Speaker

Gender Stereotypes

- **Gender** – Male or Female
 - Gender is a continuum
 - Masculine ←-----→ Feminine
- **Stereotype** – Idea we have about a person or a group before we get to know them.
- **Gender Stereotype** – Idea we have about a man or woman because they are a man or woman.

Sexual Harassment

- **Sexual Harassment** is anything that is unwanted and of a sexual nature.
- **Four Types of Sexual Harassment**
 1. Physical – Example: slapping someone's butt
 2. Verbal – Example: calling someone gay or ho
 3. Nonverbal – Example: checking someone out
 4. Written/Electronic – Example: online comments, pictures, or notes



Dating Violence

Honeymoon Phase

The abuser makes promises to be better, to change, and/or to never to do it again. The abuser often will place blame on someone or something else.



Tension Phase

Warning Signs

The abuser often angers more easily or over things that seem small.

Explosion Phase

The abuse happens.

- Verbal
- Sexual or
- Property/Financial

Consent in Relationships


- **Consent** is freely giving your permission.
- Permission has to be given both
 - verbally
 - nonverbally
- **No consent when....**
 - Afraid to change your mind or say “no”
 - Pressured/Blackmailed
 - Not Awake/Aware/Sober
 - STOP is not respected

Healthy and Unhealthy Relationships

- Relationships are about respecting **boundaries** and **communication**.
- **Boundary**: Personal limit you set for yourself.

Sexual Assault

- **Sexual Assault:** any sexual activity without CONSENT
- **Cannot give consent if...**
 - Threatened/Scared/Forces
 - Pressured/Blackmailed
 - Under the Influence
 - Under the Age of Consent (17 in MO and 16 in KS)
 - Sleeping/Passed Out
