SILVER: 25-34 hours

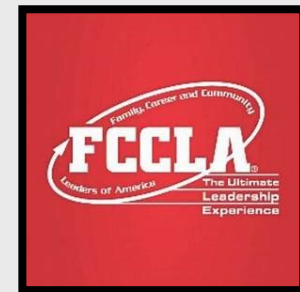
GOLD: 35+ hours
